George School Interview Questions

Please find below question suggestions for the George School taped interview. Please note that the interview must be of at least 5 minutes duration and conducted entirely in English.

Normally, when doing these interviews, it is helpful to start by asking the student an irrelevant or even silly question and/or just having a brief, relaxed conversation to put them at ease before you begin running the tape.

Begin by asking the student to tell you her/his name, age, where they are from and grade and school currently attending.

1. Why do you think you would like to attend George School? Is there something about George School that particularly appeals to you?
2. How do you like the School you are attending now? Are there things you don't like about your present school? What are your favorite subjects at school?
3. Do you enjoy studying?
4. What are your plans for university?
5. What are your career goals?
6. What are your extracurricular activities at school? Which do you enjoy most?
7. What other interests or hobbies do you have?
8. Do you do any volunteer work in your community? (If yes, what do they do?)
9. Do you have a lot of friends at school? (Or, just a few friends?) What do you like to do with your friends?
10. Do you hold any leadership positions at school? (If yes, what are they?)
11. How do you feel about leaving your friends and family to attend school in the US?
12. Do you have any questions you would like to ask me?

Obviously, the interviewer may want to depart from this "script" depending on the answers the student gives and whether or not those answers lead to another or different question on your part.
