

Affidavit of Support and Bank Letter

All international students who are applying to schools in the United States **must** present a Bank Letter and Affidavit of Support or Sponsor Letter.

An original **Bank Letter** and **Sponsor Letter** are required for your visit to the Embassy. Copies of both letters are required for St. Johnsbury Academy to issue your Form I-20.

Bank Letter: This letter must be on bank letterhead and signed by a bank executive. Amounts listed should be in U.S. dollars.

Dear Sir:

This is to certify that (name of parent) is capable of financing for the current academic year at St. Johnsbury Academy.

Deposits in excess of (amount of tuition plus any personal money) should be sufficient to meet (student's name) needs. Please note that the information provided here is strictly confidential. The bank or its officers assume no responsibility.

Sponsor Letter: This is a certified statement from student's sponsor (usually parent) guaranteeing financial support for the education of the student. A sample follows:

Dear Sir,
